Citizens for Common Sense and Efficient Government Launches in Southwest Florida to Combat Fraud, Waste, and Abuse

Southwest Florida — Citizens for Common Sense and Efficient Government (CSEG), a newly formed Florida political action committee, officially launched today with a mission to expose fraud, waste, and abuse in government while promoting transparency, fiscal responsibility, and accountability across Southwest Florida. As local governments and voters prepare for the 2026 ballot initiatives and election cycle, CSEG aims to educate the public, support common-sense reforms, and ensure taxpayer dollars are spent responsibly.

Inspired by federal and state accountability efforts such as the DOGE-style focus on efficiency championed by President Donald Trump and Florida's no-nonsense approach to governance advanced by Governor Ron DeSantis and Chief Financial Officer Blaise Ingoglia with the rebranded Florida Agency for Fiscal Oversight (FAFO). CSEG is committed to bringing those principles to the local level. The PAC will focus on research, voter education, grassroots engagement, and strategic communications to shine a light on government mismanagement and to hold current officials accountable to the people they serve.

"As Florida continues to grow, it is more important than ever that state, county, and municipal governments operate efficiently, transparently, and in the best interest of taxpayers," said CSEG Chairman Tom Shadrach. "CSEG exists to make sure voters are informed, wasteful practices are exposed, and elected officials understand that accountability is not optional."

CSEG will be actively engaging voters and supporters in the months ahead through grassroots outreach, digital and direct communications, and issue-focused advocacy as it gears up for the 2026 election cycle.
